Our God, He is Awesome!

My eyes keep filling with tears these days—not tears of sadness, but tears of joy and of AWE. We have such an awesome God, I cannot tell it all. I have seen Him move in unprecedented ways the past two weeks. The myriad ways He has answered prayer has almost "blown me away"—and He has answered prayers that I never even got a chance to pray. He is awesome—there's just no other word for our God! The Bible talks about our awesome God. The word "terrible" in the following verses actually means "awesome." Listen:

Psalm 66:5 *Come and see the works of God: he is TERRIBLE in his doing toward the children of men.*

Psalm 68:35 *O God, thou art TERRIBLE out of thy holy places: the God of Israel is he that giveth strength and power unto his people. Blessed be God.*

In this next verse, look at the progression from "great"...to "wondrous"...to "terrible"--watch:

Psalm 106:21-22 *They forgot God their saviour, which had done GREAT things in Egypt; WONDROUS works in the land of Ham, and TERRIBLE things by the Red sea.*

God is Still on the Throne

I have seen the enemy of our soul at work like never before. He has been running around like a lunatic trying to utterly destroy God's children. I am not giving old slew foot ANY credit for ANYthing—all he can do is try—and fail—because of OUR God. Unless we allow him. Oh ladies, if we can just get the revelation of who we are because of JESUS... We do not have to creep around like inferior beings...we can come boldly to the throne (Hebrews 4:16)...*we can have exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think* (Eph. 3:20)...*according to the power that worketh in us....*

Acts 1:8 tells us we shall receive power after that the Holy Ghost is come upon us. And so if we have the Holy Ghost, and therefore the power, why are we not receiving exceeding abundantly? There could be several reasons—the biggest one is lack of prayer. Something else to consider, though, is this—perhaps we ARE receiving exceeding abundantly—but it's just that we might not have waited long enough—the time isn't just ripe yet. That has been

the case for me this past week...I have received answers to things I've been praying about for a long, long time. You see, God requires that we wait on Him. And that takes patience. That takes waiting for our answers, our healing, our deliverance... waiting in thanksgiving and praise for HIS time and HIS way. And then, when it is time (see Acts 2:1, when the time has ripened and is full), our answer rolls in. Then, we find, God moves so fast! And all we can do is sit back and shake our heads in awe...when the time is ripe....

Last week I was at the Apostolic Ministry Conference in Madison, Mississippi. It was here that the Lord met with me personally and healed my body. I had waited months for that healing. But when the time was ripe...it came. I thank and praise the Lord for what He has done. We can't tell God when, how, why, or anything such thing. The secret is to wait on God. Waiting on God means loving Him, and thanking and praising Him, and allowing God to be God! Let God say when and let God say how—we have no business trying to dictate how God will run His world and His Church. God will do it—but we must be content until He moves.

Miracle at Dawn

This morning at five-something the phone rang. Emerging from a deep sleep, I heard my young grandson's voice asking for prayer. He told me that the apartment complex they live in was on fire. With the time difference, it was only three-something there. My daughter and her husband, and their five children, were all painfully waiting across the street, watching the flames and praying they would not destroy their little home. My husband and I immediately went to prayer. I arose and began to pace the floor. I raced to the computer and shot out a prayer request to everyone I knew who would pray. (If you were on that list—THANK YOU for praying!!)

The worst kind of nightmare had come true for those dearest to me—the horrible fire in the middle of the night when everyone is asleep. That is something I think most people fear. I could only thank God that my loved ones were alive!

After those first desperate prayers of a frantic mother, I began to offer up praise and thanksgiving. In fact, that was all I could do—it seemed the Lord just wouldn't let me pray any more of my little desperate prayers. And then I nestled in my recliner to read the Word. I felt such a peace. I just wanted to be close to HIM. If He never answered another prayer, I only wanted HIM. If He never blessed me—never met another need—I only wanted HIM....

A few hours later, my grandson called back. The miracle had happened! The fire had stopped just feet from their apartment. It could have consumed everything they owned—but did not. They had had to drive their car through the flames to reach safety, and it could have exploded—but did not. Because our God was not sleeping, our God was on duty, and our God was still on His throne. Glory to Him!

When I hung up the phone, the tears of gratitude exploded, because I knew it would have been such a quick and easy thing for my grandson's sweet little voice to have been stilled
